

Photography Challenge: "Morning at the Mouth of the Neretva river"

Objective: Capture the essence of the Neretva River at it's mouth in the morning by focusing on three specific themes: Patterns, Lines, and Reflections.

Challenge Guidelines:

1. Patterns:

- Look for natural patterns in the landscape, such as waves in the water, textures in the sand, or patterns on the seashells. Aim to capture the rhythm and repetition found in nature.



2. Lines:

- Focus specifically on lines created in the sand. This could include footprints, natural formations, or the patterns created by wind or water movements. Capture how these lines interact with the surrounding environment, creating a sense of depth and direction.



3. Reflections:

- Capture the reflections in the water at the mouth of the Neretva. This could be reflections of the sky, trees, or any other elements in the landscape. Pay attention to how the morning light enhances these reflections.



Submission Instructions:

- **Participants should submit three photos that each correspond to one of the themes: one photo for Patterns, one for Lines, and one for Reflections.**

Extra tips:

Take advantage of the soft, warm light during the early hours. Capture how this light interacts with the water, landscape, and surrounding elements.

Observe and photograph local wildlife, such as birds. Highlight their interactions with the environment in the context of the morning.

If possible, capture any human activities that occur in the morning, such as fishing or strolling along the riverbank. Showcase how people connect with nature in this area.

Experiment with different angles and perspectives—low shots at water level or close-ups of details that tell a story.

Enjoy capturing the unique beauty of the Neretva River in the morning!
