Types of photography



Portrait photography

Photographs of individuals, typically focused on the face, aiming to capture a person's character and emotions.



Landscape photography

Pictures of beautiful views, nature, and urban landscapes, aiming to capture the beauty of our surroundings.



Street photography

Capturing everyday life in urban streets, including street scenes, people, and urban architecture.



Documentary photography

Capturing real-life events and situations to preserve history or report facts.



Product photography

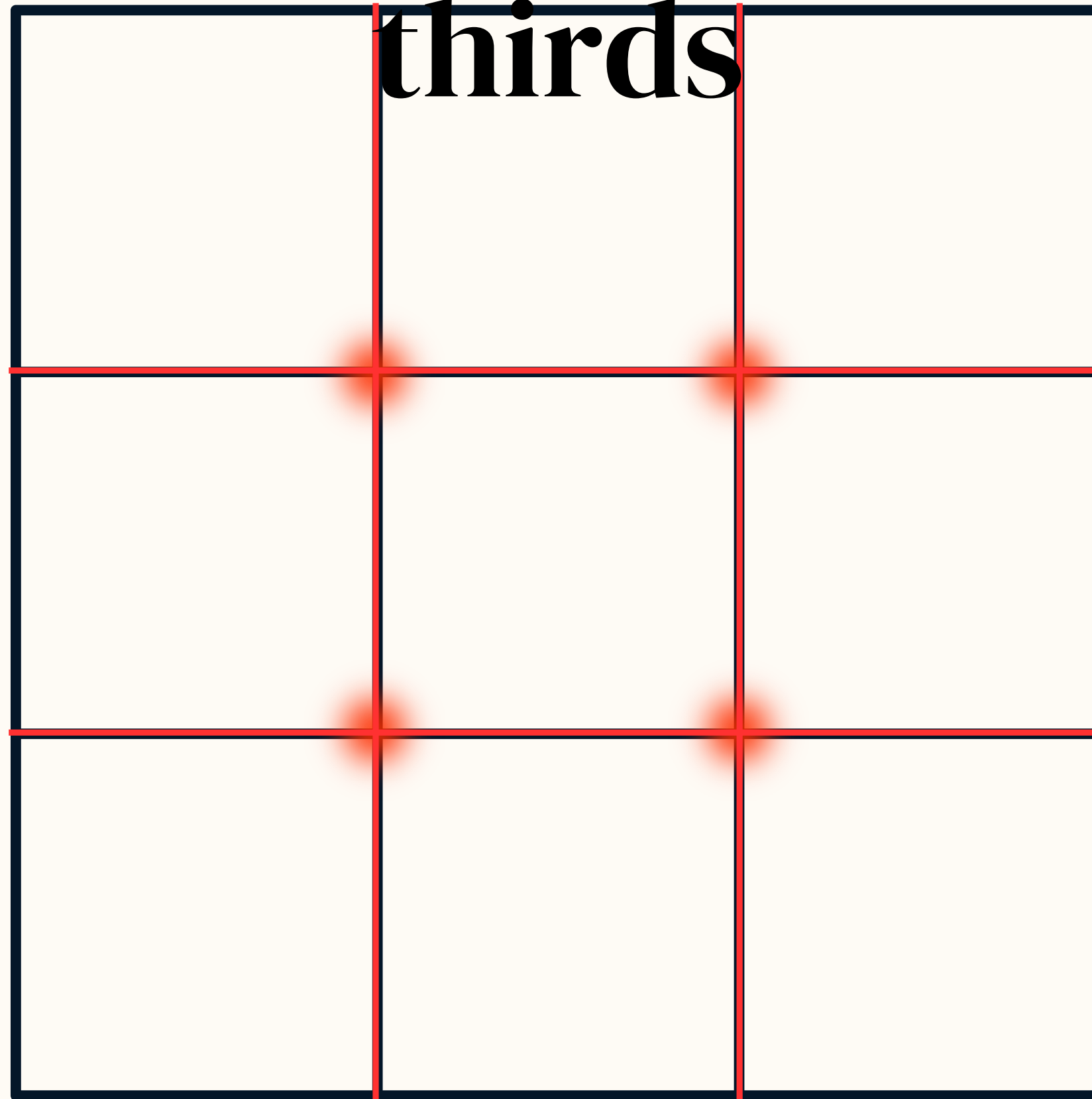
Photographing products with the intention of promoting them, often used in advertising or on e-commerce websites.

Negative space in photography refers to the unoccupied or empty areas surrounding the main subject or objects in a photograph. It is also sometimes called "white space" or "empty space".





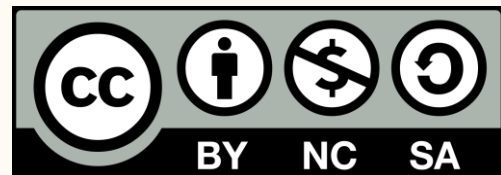
